St. Louis Regional Airport Authority “Authority” is soliciting quotes from qualified Contractors for the construction of new concrete roadways within our fuel farm facility. The project involves site preparation, subgrade work, and concrete paving to support heavy fuel transport vehicles and ensure safe operations.

This RFQ is intended to create a fair and reasonable method for obtaining responses from interested Contractors. By issuing this RFQ, the Authority is not obligated to enter into an agreement with any of the interested Contractors. The Authority reserves the right to accept or reject all proposals submitted and to waive any and/or all irregularities pertaining to the submission of proposals. Project Overview

The purpose of this RFQ is to solicit qualified Contractors to provide labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete concrete pavement installation at St Louis Regional Airport. This project will complete Phase 2 of the new Airport fuel farm access and will require the selected Contractor to construct two new access roads that will connect to Phase 1 concrete. Phase 1 is set to be poured this summer.

Scope of Services

St. Louis Regional Airport will look for the Contractor to provide services to include, but not limited to:

- Subgrade Preparation- Strip and compact subgrade
- Aggregate Base- 6" of compacted CA6
- Concrete Paving- 6" of PCC per IDOT Spec, IDOT welded wire fabric
- Joints- All joints shall be saw cut and sealed
- Utilities- JULIE will not mark the construction area. The Authority has marked all known utilities to the best of our ability and will include a rough layout in the attachments. The selected Contractor shall include costs for a private locator if deemed necessary.
- Site Layout- A site layout is provided in **Attachment C**. Perspective bidders shall set up a site visit to verify final measurements. The area to be paved has been laid out with flags.

Start date will be agreed upon by both parties.

Performance and Payment Bond

A performance and Payment Bond will be required on estimates over \$150,000.

Submission Requirements

1. Company profile and qualifications
2. Experience in similar work
3. Total cost of project
4. Timeline to complete work
5. Prevailing Wage Notice (Attachment A)
6. Company Insurance Certificate
7. Additional comments believed to be relevant

Selection Process

Submissions will be reviewed by the Authority for completeness. Evaluation will be based on the following criteria (in no specific order):

1. Qualifications and experience of contractor
2. Cost for services
3. Timeline to complete work
4. Completeness of application
5. Location of contractor

After completing a review of all submissions, the Authority may elect to inquire about further information from any or all of the Respondents. The Authority may conduct reference checks as well as inquiry to the validity of any submissions. Follow-up interviews may be scheduled as needed through the evaluation process to collect additional information for the evaluation process.

May 20, 2026, 4pm – Deadline for RFQ submission

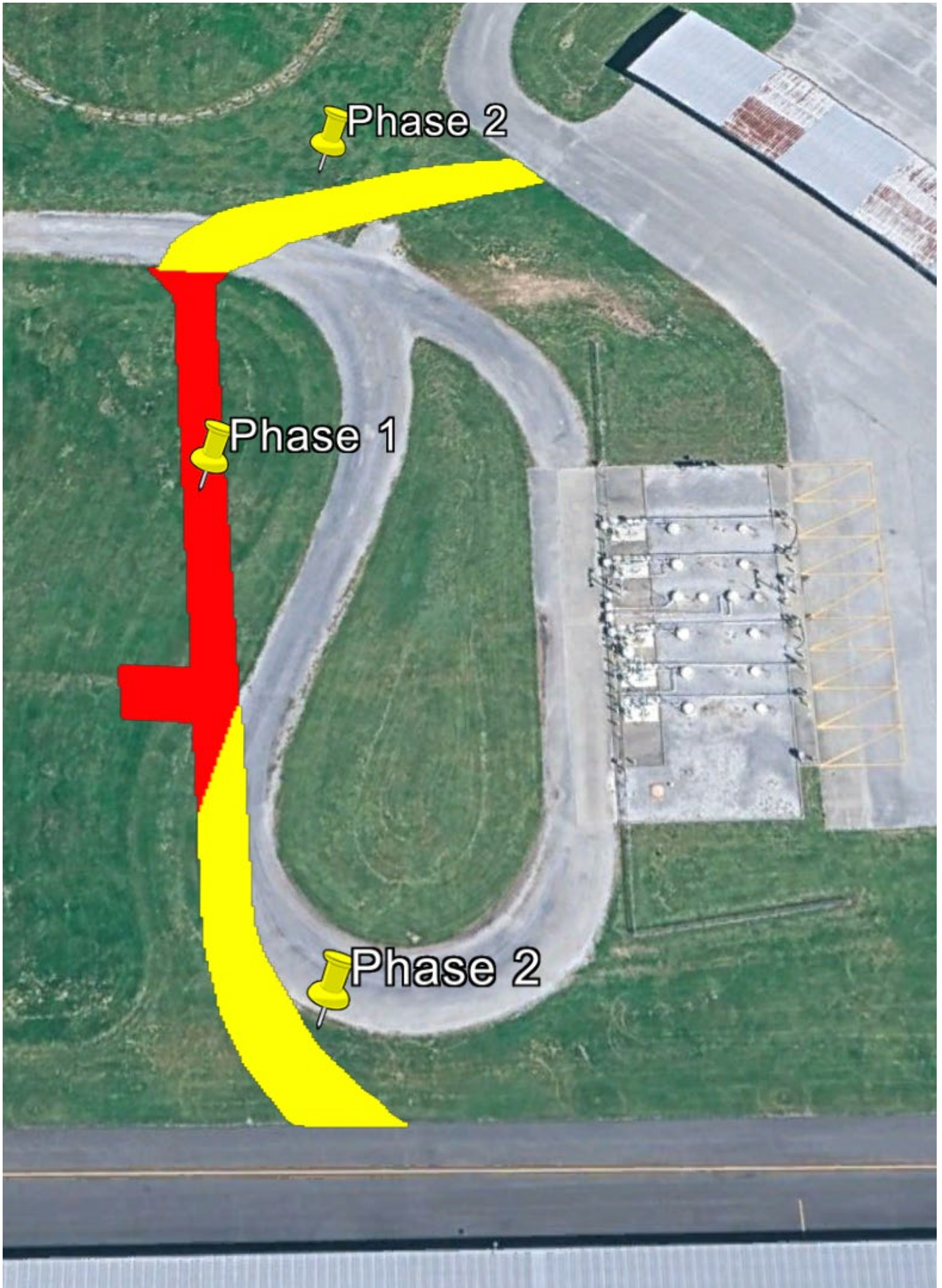
